PACS Internet & Computer use Policy

Pillager Area Charter School (PACS) believes that computer resources should be an enjoyable and educational experience. Therefore, PACS provides computing facilities to staff and students. The use of these facilities (computers, internet, and e-mail) is a privilege not a right, and any inappropriate use will result in a loss of computer privileges.

Computer / Internet / E-mail users will be expected to follow appropriate usage rules, including but not limited to:

1. Intentional abuse of computing resources or intentional interference with the work of others is prohibited.
2. Changing the wiring, configuration, or placement of computing resources is prohibited.
3. Modifying any system configuration, start-up files or application is prohibited.
4. Software installation is to be done by staff only.
5. Music or personal CD use on computers with permission.
6. Only materials, e-mails or websites that are deemed appropriate to the educational setting will be allowed. **NO PORNOGRAPHY, PROFANITIES, ILLEGAL, THREATING, ABUSIVE, PROFANE, VIOLENT OR DISCRIMINATORY SITES WILL BE ALLOWED!!**
7. You may access your e-mail account during break times.
8. All internet usage at PACS is subject to staff observation and review. Any inappropriate use may result in the loss of computer privileges. Staff will determine Consequences.
